

**Duration** 1 day

## Pre Requisites

Delegates attending this course should have a good working knowledge of Windows and FrontPage based on prior attendance on the Windows Introduction and Microsoft FrontPage Introduction courses, or from their own practical experience.

## Objectives

This one day course shows delegates how to create more complex web sites using frames, & custom FrontPage Themes, An overview of creating graphics in a photo editor & an introduction to creating forms is also included. Delegates work on a website for a fictional company to learn these skills in a practical way.

## Course Content

- **Frames**  
Setting up a framed site; choosing and modifying the frame layout;  
Handling links between frames;  
Setting appropriate frame targets;  
Resizing and locking frame dimensions;  
Working with frame borders.
- **Forms**  
Templates: using the FrontPage form template pages versus the Forms Wizard.  
Types of form field;  
Modifying form field attributes;  
Adding buttons;  
Form output handling: sending the form output to FrontPage  
server extensions, a database file or a CGI script
- **Custom Themes**  
Creating a new Theme;  
Editing an existing Theme;  
Choosing text, hyperlink & and background colours;  
Adding your own graphics to a Theme
- **Graphics**  
Graphics: choosing and using the correct file formats for web graphics;  
Improving and sizing a scanned photo;  
Creating navigation buttons and text banners.
